

## ***Canadian Navigable Waters Act***

Government of Northwest Territories hereby gives notice that an application has been made to the Minister of Transport, pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* for approval of the work described herein and its site and plans.

Pursuant to paragraph 7(2) of the said Act, Government of Northwest Territories has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the on-line Navigable Waters Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) and under registry number **10363** or, under the NPP File Number **2024-612212** a description of the following work, its site and plans:

- Bridge

The Jean Marie Bridge on Highway 1 over the Jean Marie River is being replaced at 61.44491°N and 121.23769°W. The new bridge will follow the same alignment as the old bridge. A temporary bridge and road detour will be constructed immediately upstream from the old bridge and will be in place during the construction period to allow continued travel along Highway 1.
