Power Engineers

The power engineering certification program includes maintenance of emergency generators, their start-up, operation, shutdown, their safety devices and electrical safety procedures.

Because of this training, power engineers are qualified to monitor and maintain heating systems and all the auxiliaries that pertain to heating systems. This includes boiler controls, circulating systems and all equipment in the systems such as circulating pumps.

Power engineers may also monitor and maintain air conditioning and ventilating systems. Power engineers are qualified to perform basic wiring procedures in order to maintain these systems.

Certified Oil Burner Mechanics

Certified Oil Burner Mechanics can also do basic electrical maintenance downstream of electrical disconnects for oil-fired appliances.
