Preface

Traffic collisions are in most cases preventable, and their effects are far-reaching. This is particularly true for single vehicle collisions, which are often the result of driving too fast for road conditions.

To reduce the number of injuries and fatalities from preventable traffic collisions, the Road Licensing and Safety Division of the Department of Transportation promotes the use of safety equipment, such as seat belts and helmets. Through public awareness programs, we encourage safe driving strategies and discourage harmful behaviours such as speeding, and drinking and driving. Through initiatives such as the Graduated Drivers Licence Program, we help drivers to gain experience and to make safer driving choices.

So far, the results are encouraging. For example, the number of collisions involving alcohol went down almost 16% since 2005. To further these efforts, the Government of the Northwest Territories will continue to fully support Canada's Road Safety Vision 2010 to ensure safety, communication, training, and enforcement are coordinated effectively for everyone's benefit.



Road Licensing and Safety Division continues to explore ways to improve our standard of service. Our roadside inspection unit, seen here, helps ensure commercial vehicles are safe. We have launched a program to help ensure that the NWT secure Drivers Licence and General Identification Card meet national standards. For those requiring driver and vehicle licensing services, the department's website at www.dot.gov.nt.ca provides information and forms, as well as travel advisories and road bulletins. We invite NWT residents to take advantage of these services.

1.0 Introduction

This report presents a statistical summary of the vehicle and driver population in the Northwest Territories and presents a summary of revenue, driver testing activity, convictions and suspensions. This information can be used by Program Managers, Regional Superintendents and Senior Managers to assess Road Licensing and Safety activities and monitor trends. The information in this report is derived from data maintained on the Road Licensing and Safety Motor Vehicle Information System (MVIS). A series of reports are used to extract the statistical information from MVIS.

The information is checked for reasonableness and accuracy by comparing with reports available on MVIS and the Financial Information System (FIS) as well as Northwest Territories population figures. Road Licensing and Safety Headquarters and Regional staff also have an opportunity to review the charts and tables for accuracy. Despite these measures, errors may exist due to data coding and entry, therefore, the information should be viewed with caution.

2.0 Executive Summary

Section 3.0 shows the number of registered vehicles by type and region. The table includes all vehicles with a valid registration as of December 31, 2006 and registered to an individual or company with a Northwest Territories address. Duplicate registrations are excluded by counting unique vehicle identification numbers. As of December 31, 2006, there were 31,664 registered vehicles, a 9.6 percent increase from 2005. This is the highest number of registered vehicles since 1989.

The breakdown of registered vehicles by type is an approximation based on variables including; vehicle make, vehicle model, vehicle type, style, license plate type, and gross vehicle weight. Light-duty vehicles, including passenger cars, passenger vans, sport utility vehicles and pickup trucks, comprised 74 percent of the vehicle population in 2006.

Section 4.0 presents the characteristics of licensed drivers. The tables include all Northwest Territories residents with a valid driver's license as of December 31, 2006. On this date, there were 24,432 licensed drivers, a 1.1 percent decrease from 2005. This follows a 1.8 decrease in the population of the Northwest Territories during the same period. Persons aged 65 and over comprised 3.5 percent of the driver population. Although not shown in the tables, the proportion of drivers aged 65 and over is increasing.

Section 5.0 presents revenue data from all Driver and Vehicle Licensing Offices operated by the Department of Transportation and by private contractors. The revenue is summarized by category, region and Issuing Office for all transactions taking place between April 1, 2006 and March 31, 2007. This is the most revenue ever generated in a Fiscal Year.

For the 2006/2007 Fiscal Year, revenue from the various categories is as follows:

Vehicle registrations: 3,130,096.56
 Driver testing: 88,235.00
 Driver licensing: 577,129.80
 Products and services: 689,733.00
 Total: 4,485,194.36

Section 6.0 shows the total number of driver tests conducted in the Northwest Territories between April 1, 2006 and March 31, 2007 by test type (written vs. road), class and region and shows the corresponding passing rates. In the 2006/2007 Fiscal Year, 3,344 written tests and 1,307 road tests were conducted. The corresponding passing rates were 69.9 percent and 62.4 percent, respectively.

Section 7.0 presents information on driver convictions, suspensions and demerit points of Northwest Territories drivers. The tables showing *Criminal Code* and *Motor Vehicles Act* convictions include convictions arising from offences committed by Northwest Territories residents between April 1, 2006 and March 31, 2007. The tables exclude convictions arising from offences committed outside of the Northwest Territories.

During the 2006/2007 Fiscal Year, there were 143 convictions under the *Criminal Code*, a 41 percent decrease from the previous Fiscal Year. There were 1,305 convictions under the *Motor Vehicles Act*. This is a 40 percent decrease from the previous Fiscal Year.

Section 8.0 shows the number of permits issued by type and Weigh Scale, number of Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance (CVSA) inspections conducted and number of offences under the *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act* and *Regulations* for the 2006/2007 Fiscal Year.

During 2006/2007:

- 10,201 permits were issued;
- 544 CVSA inspections were conducted; and
- 3 charges were laid under the *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act* and *Regulations*.


Section 9.0 presents information on reportable collisions in the Northwest Territories for the 2005 and 2006 calendar year. A reportable collision is an incident involving one or more motor vehicles resulting in death, personal injury or a minimum of \$1,000 in property damage. Details on traffic collisions is presented in the publication entitled "2006 NWT Traffic Collision Facts" and includes collisions occurring on the NWT Highway system. This publication contains useful information on issues that affect collisions and their severities, such as drinking and driving; unsafe speed; young and old drivers; and use of occupant restraints. 2. Trends in Registered Vehicles, 1996 to 2006




