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Introduction

This report presents a statistical summary of the vehicle and driver population in the Northwest Territories (NWT) as well as an overview of revenue, driver testing activity, convictions and suspensions. The information in this report is derived from data maintained on the DRIVES system.

The information is checked for reasonableness and accuracy by comparing with reports available on DRIVES and the System for Accountability and Management (SAM) as well as NWT population figures. Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) staff also have an opportunity to review the charts and tables for accuracy. Despite these measures, errors may exist due to data coding and entry; therefore, the information should be viewed with caution.

The 2022-23 fiscal year experienced a sustained level of driver and vehicle licensing activity. The number of registered vehicles and licensed drivers are virtually unchanged from last year. More road tests were conducted compared to 2021-22. There was also an increase in the number of suspensions issued and number of clients receiving demerit points compared to the previous year.

The Enterprise and Inuvik Weigh Scales were kept busy throughout the year. There was an increase in the number of commercial vehicle inspections carried out and number of commercial vehicle permits issued compared to 2021-22. Deh Cho Bridge toll revenue in 2022-23 exceeded \$ 4.4 million, which is a 10% increase from a year earlier.

Public safety remains a top priority for the GNWT. The GNWT worked with a vendor to develop a new road safety campaign aimed at decreasing the number of incidents on our roads and increasing awareness about bison and snowmobile safety, impaired driving by alcohol and drugs, occupant restraints, and distracted driving. Safety issues in this campaign will be tied to a central theme that will be readily recognizable by Northwest Territories residents. The GNWT is monitoring the effectiveness of mandatory entry-level training (ELT) for new Class 1 drivers (bus and truck drivers) which was implemented in 2021-22. Starting January 2023 commercial carriers that operate outside of the Northwest Territories are required to have electronic logging devices. Carriers that operate within the Northwest Territories are exempt from this requirement.

The updated and improved Driver and Vehicle Services website is proving to be popular with the public. Over 52 % of driver and vehicle licensing transactions were conducted online in 2022-23, which is an increase from previous years.

The GNWT will continue to work with road safety stakeholders and will monitor road safety issues and trends across the country to ensure we can deliver safe, secure, accessible and reliable movement of people and goods across the NWT.

Présentation

Ce rapport présente un résumé statistique sur les véhicules et les conducteurs aux TNO, ainsi qu'un résumé des revenus, des examens de conduite, des condamnations et des suspensions. Les renseignements contenus dans le présent rapport sont tirés de données conservées dans le système DRIVES.

Les renseignements sont vérifiés pour s'assurer de leur caractère raisonnable et de leur exactitude au moyen de comparaisons avec les rapports disponibles dans le système DRIVES et le système de comptabilité et de gestion (SAM), et au moyen des données sur la population des TNO. Le personnel du gouvernement des Territoires du Nord-Ouest (GTNO) peut aussi vérifier l'exactitude des graphiques et des tableaux concernés. En dépit de ces mesures, des erreurs peuvent se glisser dans les données pendant leur codage et leur saisie. Par conséquent, on doit examiner ces renseignements avec prudence.

Lors de l'exercice 2022-2023, l'activité relative à l'immatriculation et aux permis de conduire était soutenue. Le nombre d'immatriculations et de permis de conduire est virtuellement resté inchangé par rapport à l'exercice précédent. Il y a eu davantage d'examens pratiques de conduite par rapport à 2021-2022. On a également constaté un nombre accru de conducteurs ayant perdu des points d'inaptitude par rapport à l'exercice précédent.

Les stations de pesage d'Enterprise et d'Inuvik ont été occupées tout au long de l'année. On a constaté une hausse des inspections des véhicules commerciaux, ainsi qu'une augmentation de permis de véhicules commerciaux délivrés par rapport à 2021-2022. Les recettes de péage du pont de Dehcho ont dépassé 4,4 millions de dollars en 2022-2023, soit une hausse de 10 % par rapport à l'année précédente.

La sécurité du public reste l'une des priorités absolues du GTNO. Celui-ci a collaboré avec un prestataire afin de mettre au point une nouvelle campagne de sécurité routière visant à faire baisser le nombre d'incidents sur les routes et à sensibiliser davantage les gens à la sécurité (bison et motoneige), à la conduite avec facultés affaiblies par l'alcool et les drogues, aux dispositifs de retenue des occupants et à la distraction au volant. Les questions de sécurité abordées dans le cadre de cette campagne auront un thème commun, que les Ténois pourront aisément reconnaître. Le GTNO fait le suivi de l'efficacité de la formation de base obligatoire pour les nouveaux conducteurs titulaires d'un permis de classe 1 (bus et camions), introduite en 2021-2022. Depuis janvier 2023, les transporteurs commerciaux en activité à l'extérieur des Territoires du Nord-Ouest sont tenus d'utiliser des dispositifs de consignation électronique. Les transporteurs en activité aux Territoires du Nord-Ouest sont exemptés de cette exigence.

Le site Web des Services de l'immatriculation et des permis de conduire est populaire auprès du public. Plus de 52 % des opérations liées à l'immatriculation et aux permis de conduire ont été effectuées en ligne en 2022-2023, soit une hausse par rapport aux années précédentes.

Le GTNO continuera à collaborer avec les intervenants en sécurité routière et surveillera les tendances et les enjeux dans ce domaine partout au pays pour garantir la circulation sûre, libre et fiable des personnes et des biens partout aux TNO.

Le GTNO aimerait remercier tout particulièrement la GRC pour son assistance et sa collaboration.

Section Summaries

Section 3.0 shows the number of registered vehicles by type and region. The table includes all vehicles with a valid registration as of December 31, 2022 and registered to an individual or company with a NWT address. Duplicate registrations are excluded by counting unique vehicle identification numbers. As of December 31, 2022, there were 41,930 registered vehicles, an 0.6 % decrease from 2021.

The breakdown of registered vehicles by type is an approximation based on variables including; vehicle make, vehicle model, vehicle type, style, license plate type, and gross vehicle weight. Light-duty vehicles, including passenger cars, passenger vans, sport utility vehicles and pickup trucks, comprised 73 % of the vehicle population in 2022.

Section 4.0 presents the characteristics of licensed drivers. The tables include all NWT residents with a valid driver's license as of December 31, 2022. On this date, there were 26,471 licensed drivers, a 0.7 % decrease from 2021. The population of the NWT increased by 0.2 % during the same period. Persons aged 65 and over comprised 12.0 % of the driver population. Although not shown in the tables, the proportion of drivers aged 65 continues to increase.

Section 5.0 presents revenue data from all Driver and Vehicle offices and online services operated by the Department of Infrastructure (INF) and by private contractors. The revenue is summarized by category, region and office for all transactions taking place between April 1, 2022 and March 31, 2023.

For the 2022/2023 Fiscal Year, revenue from the various categories is as follows:

Section 6.0 shows the total number of driver tests conducted in the NWT between April 1, 2022, and March 31, 2023, by test type (written vs. road), class and region and shows the corresponding passing rates. In 2022/2023, 7,884 written tests and 1,744 road tests were conducted. The corresponding passing rates were 60.5 % and 60.4 %, respectively.

Section 7.0 presents information on convictions, suspensions and demerit points of NWT drivers. The tables showing convictions under the *Criminal Code*, *Motor Vehicles Act* and *Regulations*, *All-Terrain Vehicles Act* and municipal bylaws include convictions arising from traffic offences committed in the NWT between April 1, 2022 and March 31, 2023. The tables exclude convictions arising from offences committed outside of the NWT.

During the 2022/2023 fiscal year, there were 198 convictions under the *Criminal Code*, a 138.6 % increase from the previous fiscal year. There were 1,572 convictions under the *Motor Vehicles Act*. This is a 37.9 % increase from 2022/2023.

Section 8.0 shows the number of permits issued by type and issuing location, number of Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance (CVSA) inspections conducted and number of commercial transport-related convictions under the *Motor Vehicles Act* and *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act* for the 2022/2023 fiscal year.

This section also includes the number of Deh Cho Bridge toll permits issued by toll class and associated revenue. During 2022/2023:

- 19,378 permits were issued;
- 613 CVSA inspections were conducted;
- There were 64 commercial transport-related convictions under the *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act and Regulations* as well as under commercial transport-related regulations pursuant to the *Motor Vehicles Act*; and
- \$4,481,923.00 in Deh Cho Bridge toll revenue was collected between April 1, 2022, and March 31, 2023.

Section 9.0 presents a summary of reportable collisions in the NWT for the 2021 and 2022 calendar years. A reportable collision is an incident involving one or more motor vehicles resulting in death, personal injury or a minimum of \$2,000 in property damage in the absence of deaths or injuries. Details on traffic collisions are presented in the publication entitled *2022 NWT Traffic Collision Facts* and include collisions occurring on the NWT Highway system. This publication contains useful information on issues that affect collisions and their severities, such as drinking and driving; unsafe speed; young and old drivers; and use of occupant restraints. 




















Trends in Commercial Transport Permits, 2012/2013 to 2022/2023
