Introduction

This report presents a statistical summary of the vehicle and driver population in the Northwest Territories (NWT) as well as an overview of revenue, driver testing activity, convictions and suspensions. The information in this report is derived from data maintained on the DRIVES system.

The information is checked for reasonableness and accuracy by comparing with reports available on DRIVES and the System for Accountability and Management (SAM) as well as NWT population figures. Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) staff also have an opportunity to review the charts and tables for accuracy. Despite these measures, errors may exist due to data coding and entry; therefore, the information should be viewed with caution.

The 2024/2025 fiscal year demonstrated steady activity within the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Program. As of December 31, 2024, 43,164 vehicles were registered in the NWT, marking a record high for the second consecutive year. On the same date, 27,442 individuals held active driver's licenses, also reaching another record high. More road and written tests were conducted compared to 2023/2024. There was also a decrease in the number of clients receiving demerit points but an increase in suspensions issued compared to the previous year.

The Enterprise and Inuvik Weigh Scales remained active throughout the year. There was a 45% increase in the number of commercial vehicle permits issued. This is primarily attributable to the introduction of carbon tax permits. Highway Transport Officers were able to devote more time to conducting Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance (CVSA) inspections, resulting in a 43% increase compared to 2023/2024. Deh Cho Bridge toll revenue was about 15% greater than in 2023/2024 and is the most revenue generated in one year since the bridge opened in 2012.

In August 2024 the GNWT launched DriveNWT which provides the travelling public with up-to-date information on highway conditions, road closures, construction activities and the status of winter roads, ferries and ice crossings. DriveNWT replaces the Highway Conditions Map which had been in place since 2013.

With increased truck traffic for Sahtu community fuel resupply on the Mackenzie Valley Winter Road in the 2024/2025 season, INF introduced multiple safety initiatives to safeguard travelers and preserve the road's condition. These efforts included road widening where feasible, enhanced maintenance patrols, provision of emergency fuel, speed limit enforcement at checkpoints, and a public safety campaign featuring driver handouts, maps, social media outreach, website updates, and various advertisements.

The GNWT remains dedicated to collaborating with road safety stakeholders and closely monitoring both regional and national road safety trends. These efforts aim to ensure the safe, secure, and reliable movement of people and goods throughout the NWT.

Présentation

Ce rapport présente un résumé statistique sur les véhicules et les conducteurs aux TNO, ainsi qu'un résumé des revenus, des examens de conduite, des condamnations et des suspensions. Les renseignements contenus dans le présent rapport sont tirés de données conservées dans le système DRIVES.

Les renseignements sont vérifiés pour en assurer le caractère raisonnable et l'exactitude en les comparant avec les rapports disponibles dans le système DRIVES et dans le système de comptabilité et de gestion (SAM), et au moyen des données sur la population des TNO. Le personnel du gouvernement des Territoires du Nord-Ouest (GTNO) peut aussi vérifier l'exactitude des graphiques et des tableaux concernés. Malgré ces mesures, des erreurs peuvent se glisser dans les données pendant leur codage et leur saisie. Par conséquent, on doit examiner ces renseignements avec prudence.

Lors de l'exercice financier 2024-2025, l'activité relative à l'immatriculation et aux permis de conduire est demeurée stable. En date du 31 décembre 2024, les Territoires du Nord-Ouest comptaient 43 164 véhicules immatriculés, un niveau record pour une deuxième année consécutive. À la même date, 27 442 individus détenaient un permis de conduire, un autre niveau record pour les TNO. Un plus grand nombre de tests écrits et pratiques ont été effectués en 2024-2025 par rapport à 2023-2024. On a également constaté une diminution du nombre de clients qui ont accumulé des points d'inaptitude, mais une hausse du nombre de suspensions imposées par rapport à l'année précédente.

Les stations de pesage d'Enterprise et d'Inuvik sont demeurées actives tout au long de l'année. On a observé une hausse de 45 % du nombre de permis délivrés aux véhicules commerciaux, ce qui est principalement attribuable à l'introduction des permis liés à la taxe sur le carbone. Les agents du transport routier ont pu consacrer davantage de temps aux inspections menées dans le cadre de l'Alliance pour la sécurité des véhicules commerciaux (CVSA), ce qui a entraîné une augmentation de 43 % par rapport à 2023-2024. Les revenus provenant du péage du pont de Deh Cho ont été supérieurs d'environ 15 % à ceux de 2023-2024, ce qui représente la plus importante somme générée en une seule année depuis l'ouverture du pont en 2012.

En août 2024, le GTNO a lancé RoutesTNO, un outil qui fournit au public des renseignements à jour sur l'état des routes, les fermetures, les travaux de construction ainsi que sur les routes d'hiver, les traversiers et les ponts de glace. RoutesTNO remplace la carte des conditions routières, en place depuis 2013.

En raison de l'augmentation de la circulation de camions pour l'approvisionnement en carburant des collectivités du Sahtu sur la route d'hiver de la vallée du Mackenzie durant la saison 2024-2025, le ministère de l'Infrastructure (INF) a mis en place plusieurs initiatives de sécurité afin de protéger les usagers et la route. Ces mesures comprenaient l'élargissement de la route quand c'était possible, l'intensification des patrouilles d'entretien, la mise à disposition de carburant d'urgence, l'application des limites de vitesse aux points de contrôle ainsi qu'une campagne de sécurité publique comportant des dépliants pour les conducteurs, des cartes, des publications sur les médias sociaux, des mises à jour du site Web et des publicités.

Le GTNO reste déterminé à collaborer avec les intervenants en sécurité routière, et à surveiller de près les tendances liées à la sécurité sur les routes régionales et nationales. Ce travail permet d'assurer la circulation sécuritaire et fiable des personnes et des biens partout aux TNO.

Le GTNO aimerait remercier tout particulièrement la GRC pour son assistance et sa collaboration.

Section Summaries

Section 3.0 shows the number of registered vehicles by type and region. The table includes all vehicles with a valid registration as of December 31, 2024 and registered to an individual or company with a NWT address. Duplicate registrations are excluded by counting unique vehicle identification numbers. As of December 31, 2024, there were 43,164 registered vehicles, a 1.8 % increase from 2023.

The breakdown of registered vehicles by type is an approximation based on variables including; vehicle make, vehicle model, vehicle type, style, license plate type, and gross vehicle weight. Light-duty vehicles, including passenger cars, passenger vans, sport utility vehicles and pickup trucks, comprised 73 % of the vehicle population in 2024.

Section 4.0 presents the characteristics of licensed drivers. The tables include all NWT residents with a valid driver's license as of December 31, 2024. On this date, there were 27,442 licensed drivers, a 2.3 % increase from 2023. The population of the NWT decreased by 0.5 % during the same period. Persons aged 65 and over comprised 13.1 % of the driver population. Although not shown in the tables, the proportion of drivers aged 65 continues to increase.

Section 5.0 presents revenue data from all Driver and Vehicle offices and online services operated by the Department of Infrastructure (INF) and by private contractors. The revenue is summarized by category, region and office for all transactions taking place between April 1, 2024 and March 31, 2025.

Section 6.0 shows the total number of driver tests conducted in the NWT between April 1, 2024, and March 31, 2025, by test type (written vs. road), class and region and shows the corresponding passing rates. In 2024/2025, 10,483 written tests and 2,249 road tests were conducted. The corresponding passing rates were 65.5 % and 51.7 %, respectively.

Section 7.0 presents information on convictions, suspensions and demerit points of NWT drivers. The tables showing convictions under the *Criminal Code*, *Motor Vehicles Act* and *Regulations*, *All-Terrain Vehicles Act* and municipal bylaws include convictions arising from traffic offences committed in the NWT between April 1, 2024 and March 31, 2025. The tables exclude convictions arising from offences committed outside of the NWT.

During the 2024/2025 fiscal year, there were 216 convictions under the *Criminal Code*, a 2.9 % increase from the previous fiscal year. There were 1,384 convictions under the *Motor Vehicles Act*. This is a 14.3 % decrease from 2023/2024.

Section 8.0 shows the number of permits issued by type and issuing location, number of Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance (CVSA) inspections conducted and number of commercial transport-related convictions under the *Motor Vehicles Act* and *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act* for the 2024/2025 fiscal year.

This section also includes the number of Deh Cho Bridge toll permits issued by toll class and associated revenue. During 2024/2025:

- 30,066 permits were issued;
- 656 CVSA inspections were conducted;
- There were 120 commercial transport-related convictions under the *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act and Regulations* as well as under commercial transport-related regulations pursuant to the *Motor Vehicles Act*; and
- \$4,748,477.00 in Deh Cho Bridge toll revenue was collected between April 1, 2024, and March 31, 2025.

Section 9.0 presents a summary of reportable collisions in the NWT for the 2023 and 2024 calendar years. A reportable collision is an incident involving one or more motor vehicles resulting in death, personal injury or a minimum of \$2,000 in property damage in the absence of deaths or injuries. Details on traffic collisions are presented in the publication entitled *2024 NWT Traffic Collision Facts* and include collisions occurring on the NWT Highway system. This publication contains useful information on issues that affect collisions and their severities, such as drinking and driving; unsafe speed; young and old drivers; and use of occupant restraints. 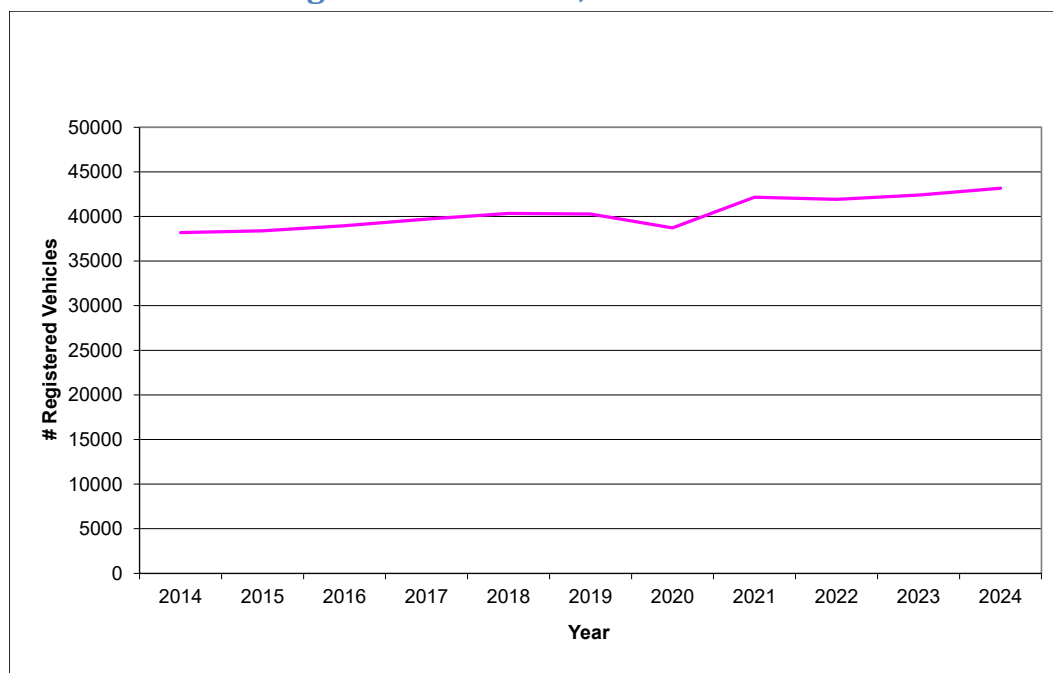

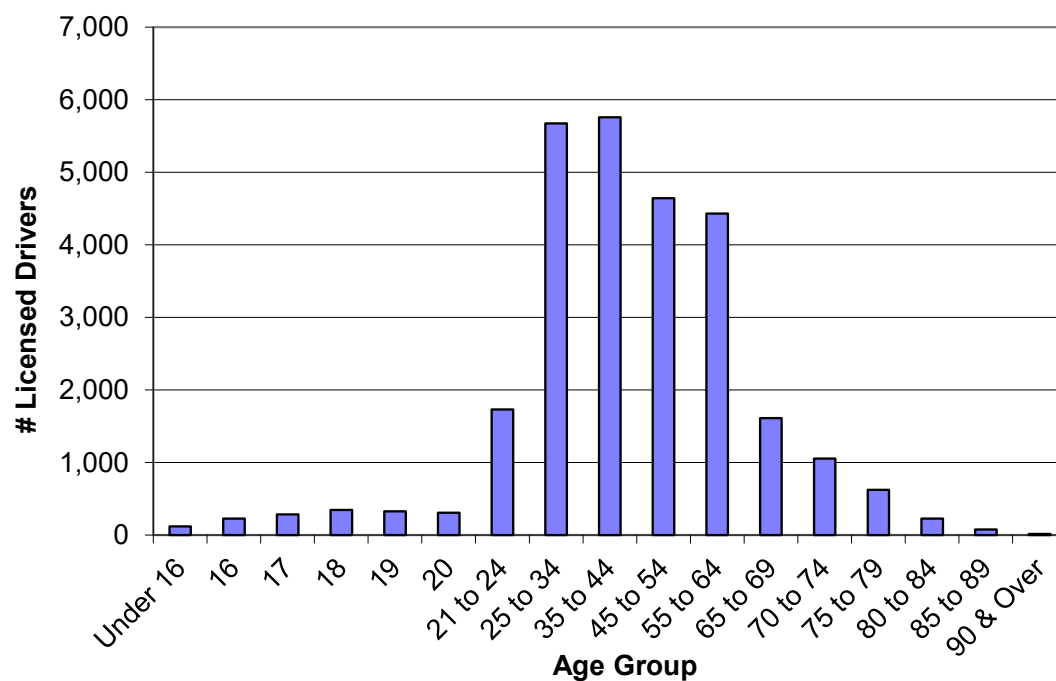

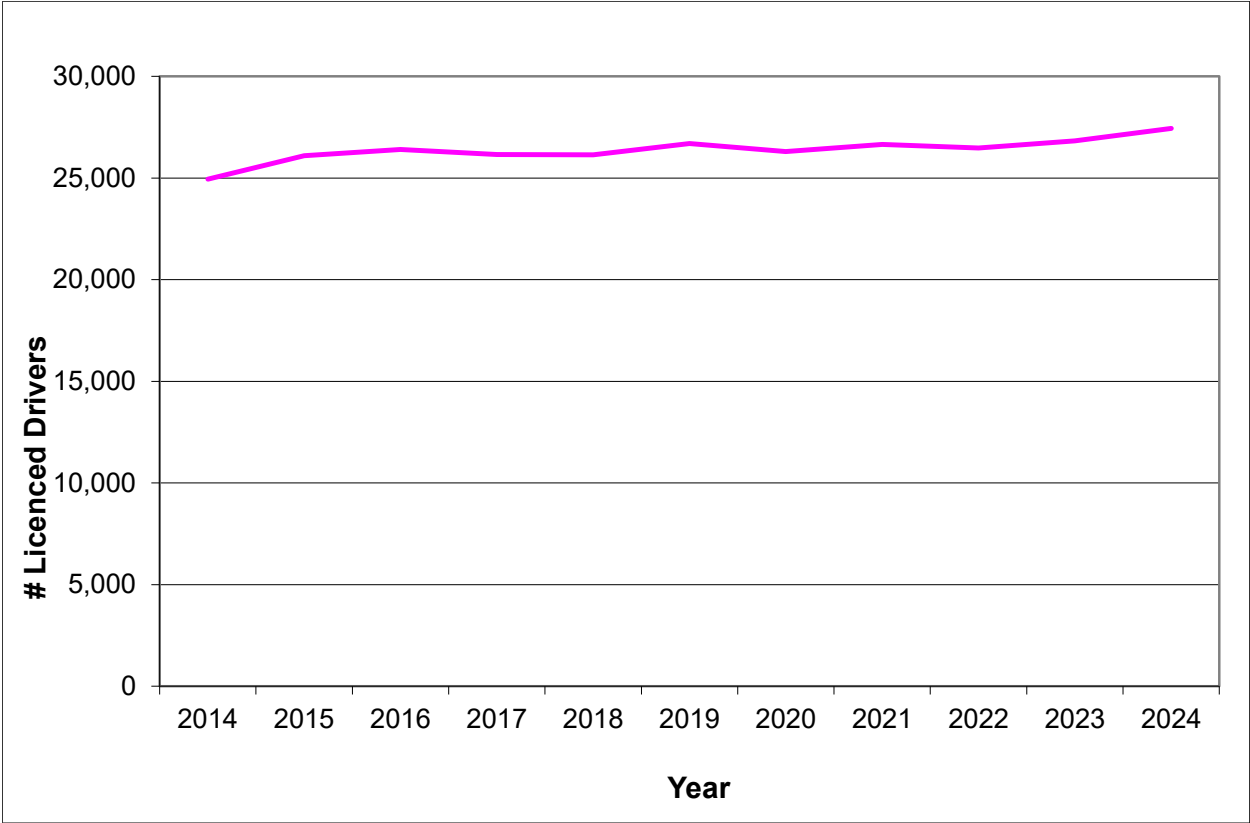

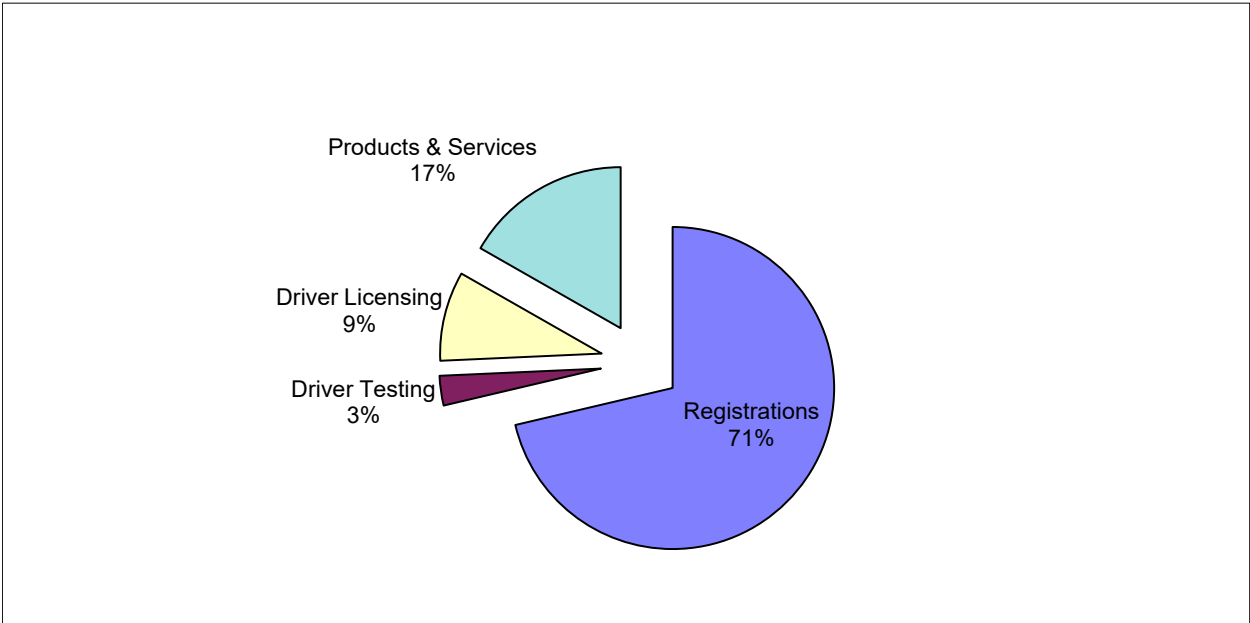

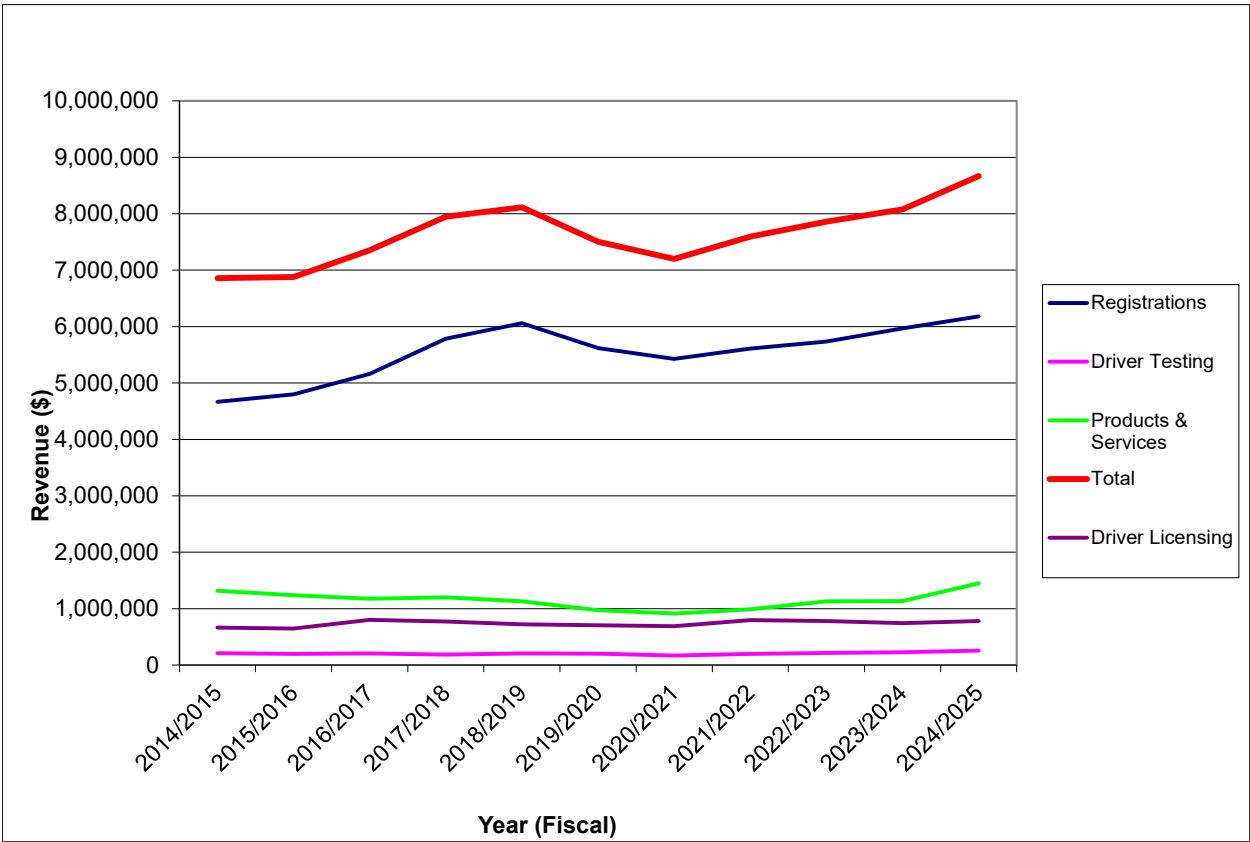

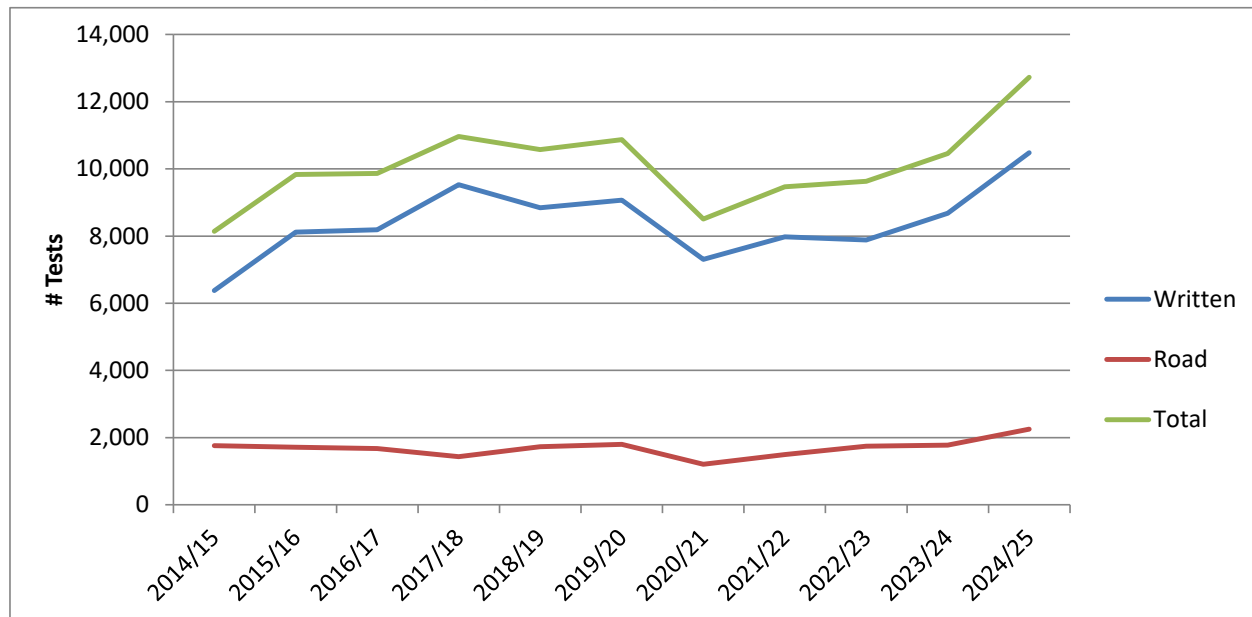

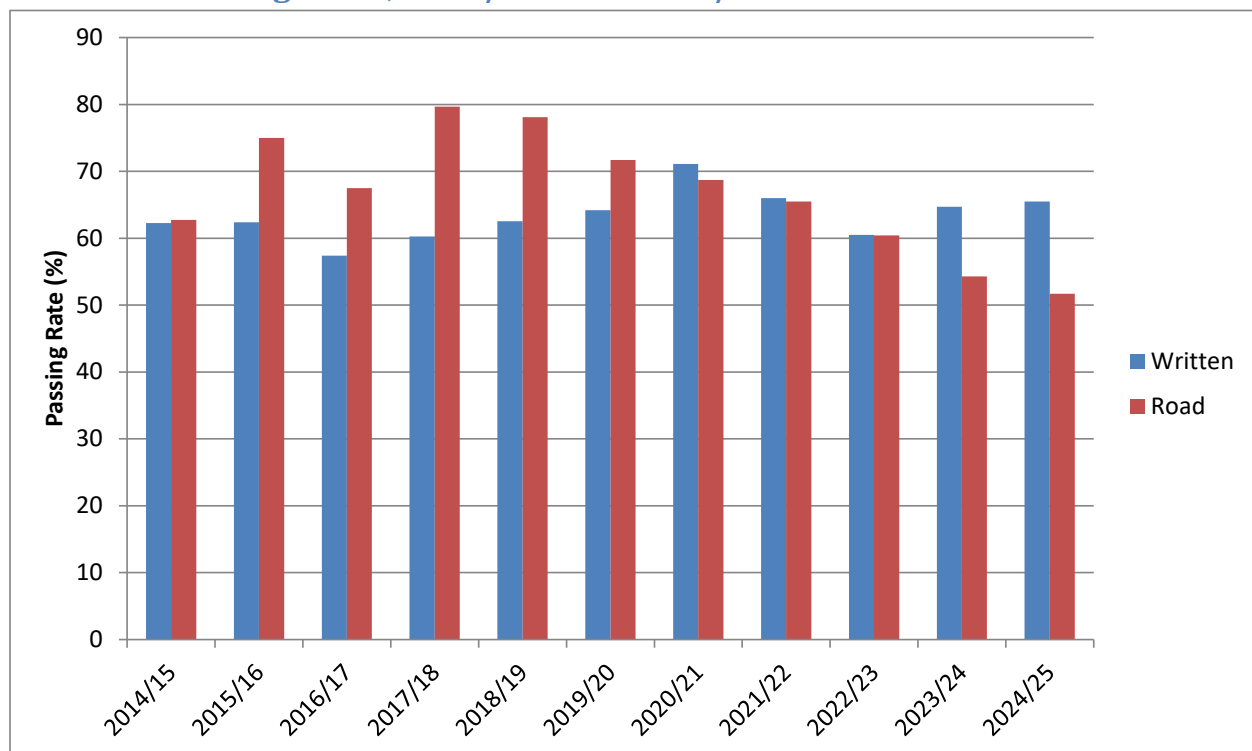

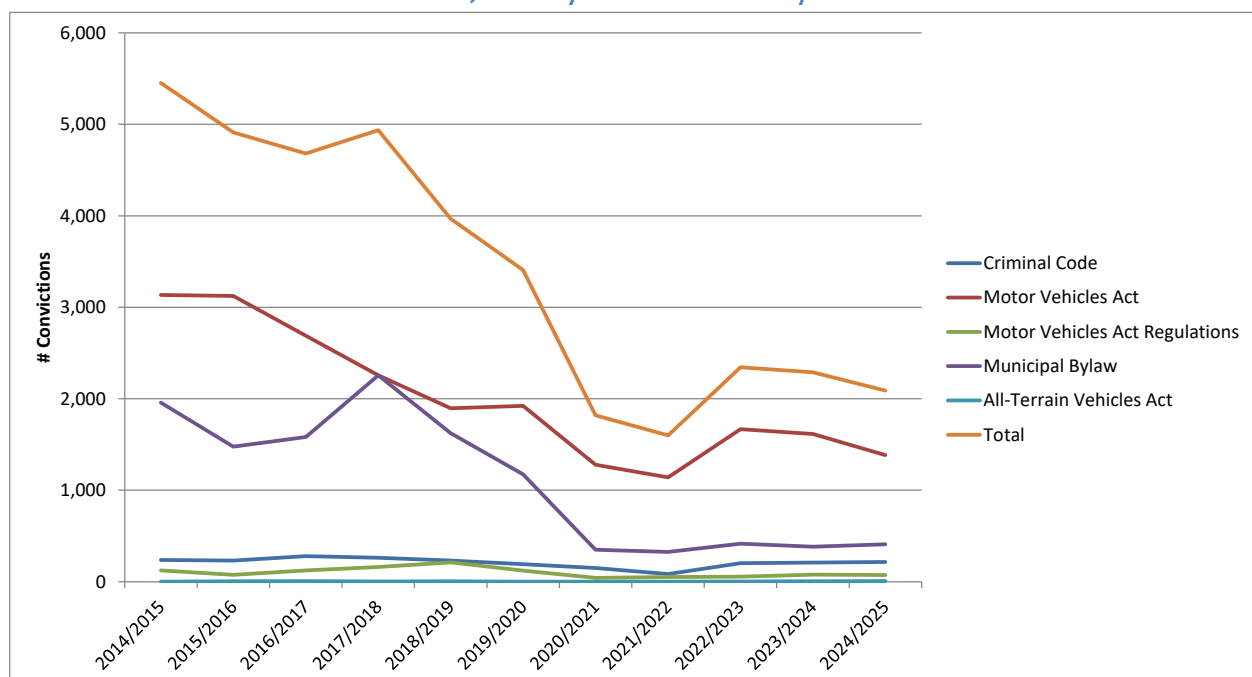

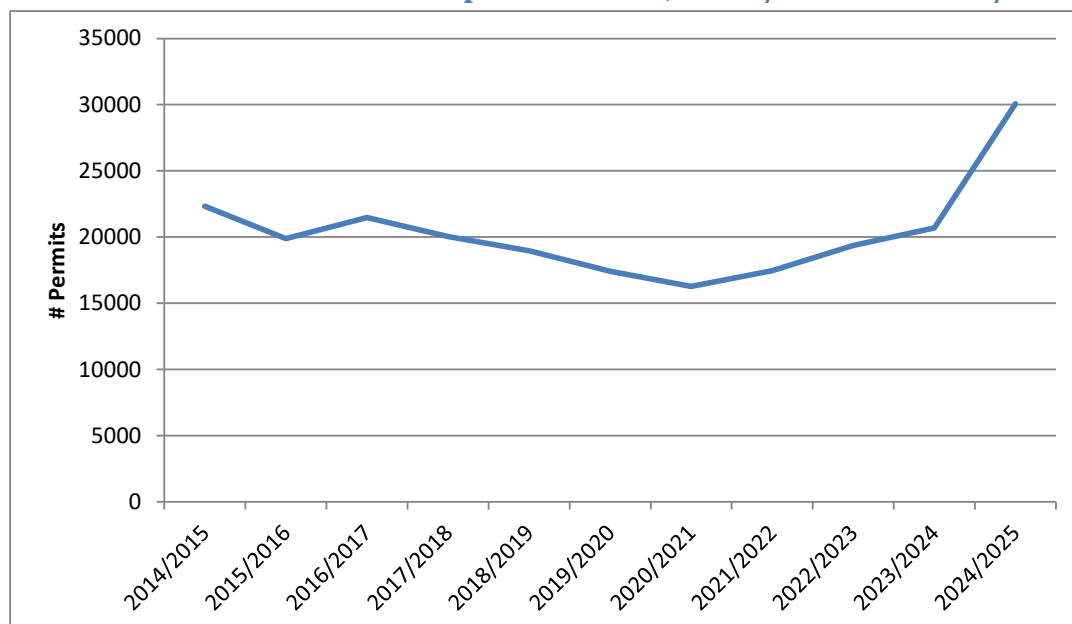

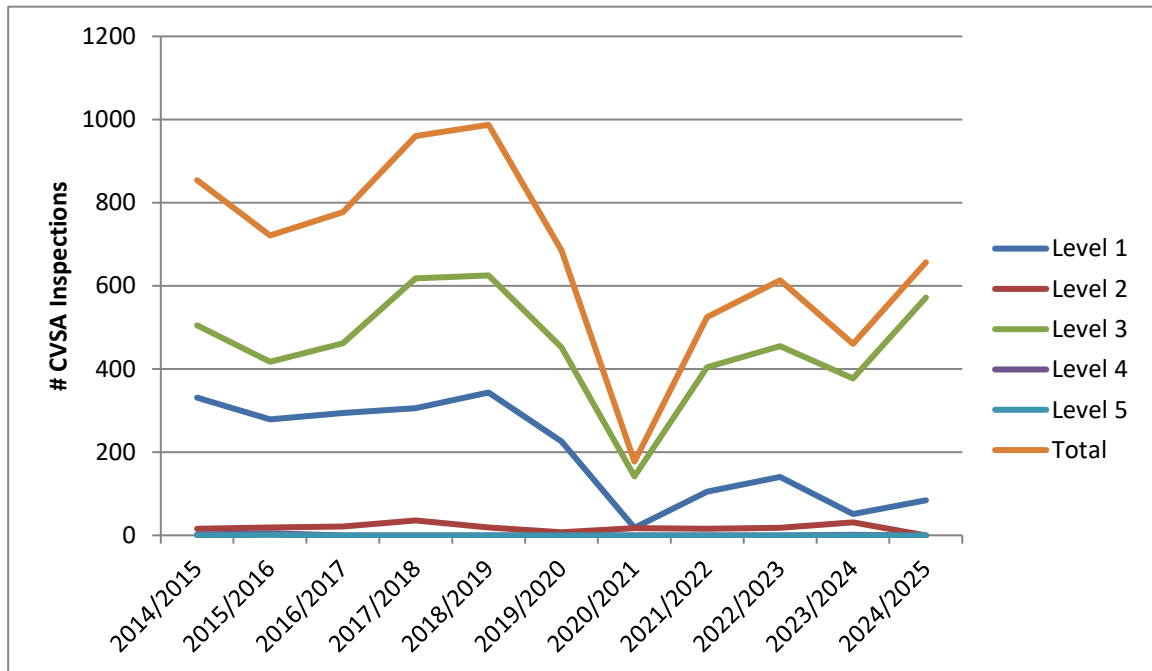

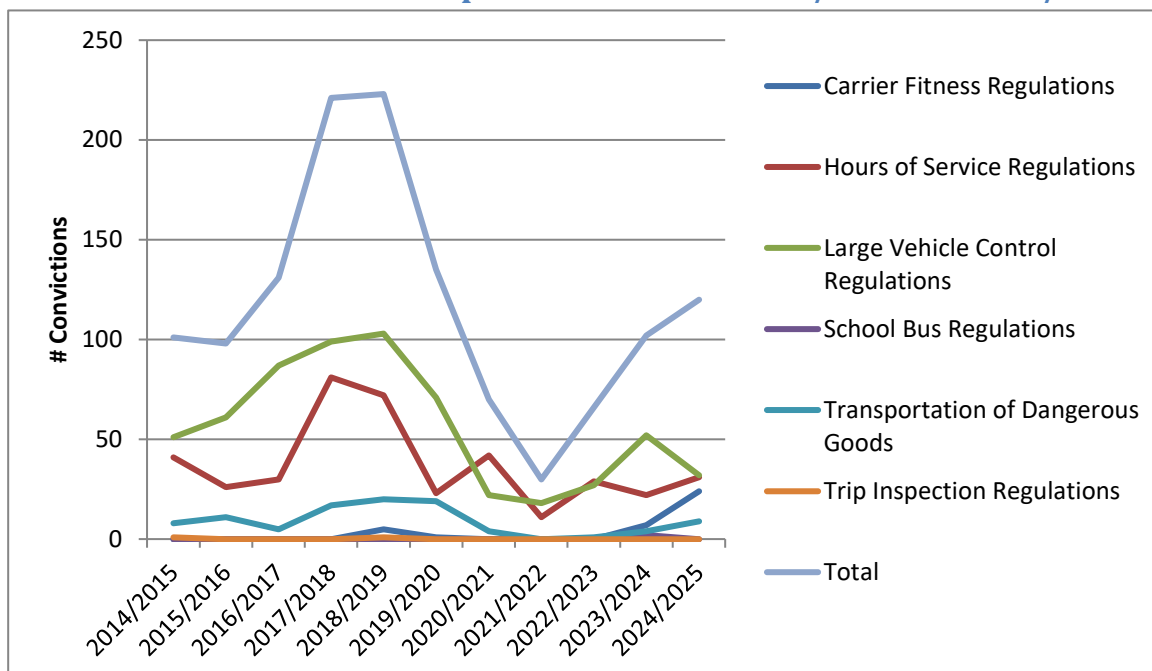
Trends in Commercial Transport Permits, 2014/2015 to 2024/2025
