Preface

The Road Licensing and Safety Division (RL&S) coordinates and leads the Department of Transportation's (DOT's) road licensing and regulatory responsibilities. There are many challenges in filling this role in a territory the size of the NWT where the cost of providing services must be balanced against our objective of improving service to all residents.

RL&S continually strives to improve driver and vehicle licensing services in all communities. DOT has developed a new E-notification service that will satisfy the needs of many of our clients. E-notification is a communications tool that provides DOT clients with important reminders via e-mail and optionally by SMS text messaging. E-notifications will be part of DOT's commitment to providing cost-effective, fast, and reliable services to our clients, wherever and whenever they are needed. As well, RL&S now has a new website, which is user friendly and easy to navigate.

The newly implemented DRIVES system has effectively replaced many of the previous Motor Vehicle Information System (MVIS) capabilities. The new Driver Profile module, which was implemented in early 2013, incorporates new technologies to administer an increased and enhanced suspension, restriction and demerit points program.

The launch of the Drive Alive program pulls together a number of travel-safety campaigns in the NWT. Drive Alive works with private and government partners to achieve a simple objective—making NWT residents aware of the need to make safe choices whether they are pedestrians, passengers or operators of a vehicle or boat on our roads, trails, and waterways.

RL&S launched the *Alcohol Ignition Interlock Program* on February 1st, 2013. This program allows drivers with impaired driving convictions to use a breath-screening device that prevents the vehicle from starting if the driver's BAC exceeds a pre-set limit. The companion *High Risk Drivers Program* (HRDP) is currently under development. The HRDP will enhance public safety by implementing tougher sanctions for high-risk behavior and by imposing mandatory remedial education as required. The HRDP will complement and bolster existing programs—including the *Driver's Licence Demerit Point Program* and the *Alcohol Ignition Interlock Program*—by focusing on drivers who continue to engage in dangerous behaviours despite prior interventions (e.g., suspensions).

Supporting legislation for the HRDP includes amendments to the *Motor Vehicles Act*, currently underway, and amendments to the *Driver's Licence Demerit Point Regulations*. These amendments will improve program administration and the revised demerit point program will also serve as a filter, allowing the HRDP to focus on the most extreme problem drivers. A new, consolidated set of regulations—the *Driver Conduct Review Regulations*—will incorporate these amendments as well as new provisions related to the HRDP into a single, effective piece of legislation.

As always, RL&S is working in co-operation with municipal enforcement and the RCMP to coordinate enforcement activities and enhance public safety.

We welcome ideas from communities and other stakeholders as we continue our efforts to better serve the residents of the NWT.

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1.0 Introduction

This report presents a statistical summary of the vehicle and driver population in the Northwest Territories and presents a summary of revenue, driver testing activity, convictions and suspensions. This information can be used by Program Managers, Regional Superintendents and Senior Managers to assess Road Licensing and Safety activities and monitor trends. The information in this report is derived from data maintained on the Road Licensing and Safety Motor Vehicle Information System (MVIS). A series of reports are used to extract the statistical information from MVIS.

The information is checked for reasonableness and accuracy by comparing with reports available on MVIS and the Financial Information System (FIS) as well as Northwest Territories population figures. Road Licensing and Safety Headquarters and Regional staff also have an opportunity to review the charts and tables for accuracy. Despite these measures, errors may exist due to data coding and entry, therefore, the information should be viewed with caution.

2.0 Executive Summary

Section 3.0 shows the number of registered vehicles by type and region. The table includes all vehicles with a valid registration as of December 31, 2012 and registered to an individual or company with a Northwest Territories address. Duplicate registrations are excluded by counting unique vehicle identification numbers. As of December 31, 2012, there were 34,655 registered vehicles, a 7.0 percent increase from 2011.

The breakdown of registered vehicles by type is an approximation based on variables including; vehicle make, vehicle model, vehicle type, style, license plate type, and gross vehicle weight. Light-duty vehicles, including passenger cars, passenger vans, sport utility vehicles and pickup trucks, comprised 73 percent of the vehicle population in 2012.

Section 4.0 presents the characteristics of licensed drivers. The tables include all Northwest Territories residents with a valid driver's license as of December 31, 2012. On this date, there were 24,745 licensed drivers, a 0.2 percent increase from 2011. The population of the Northwest Territories decreased by 0.7 percent during the same period. Persons aged 65 and over comprised 6.3 percent of the driver population. Although not shown in the tables, the proportion of drivers aged 65 and over is increasing.

Section 5.0 presents revenue data from all Driver and Vehicle Licensing Offices operated by the Department of Transportation and by private contractors. The revenue is summarized by category, region and Issuing Office for all transactions taking place between April 1, 2012 and March 31, 2013.

For the 2012/2013 Fiscal Year, revenue from the various categories is as follows:

- Vehicle registrations: \$3,873,990.00
- Driver testing: \$109,940.00
- Driver licensing: \$501,814.00
- Products and services: \$1,059,257.00
- Total: \$5,545,001.00

Section 6.0 shows the total number of driver tests conducted in the Northwest Territories between April 1, 2012 and March 31, 2013 by test type (written vs. road), class and region and shows the corresponding passing rates. In the 2012/2013 Fiscal Year, 3,529 written tests and 1,373 road tests were conducted. The corresponding passing rates were 71.4 percent and 74.2 percent, respectively.

Section 7.0 presents information on driver convictions, suspensions and demerit points of Northwest Territories drivers. The tables showing convictions under the *Criminal Code*, *Motor Vehicles Act* and *Regulations*, *All Terrain Vehicles Act* and municipal bylaws include convictions arising from traffic offences committed in the Northwest Territories between April 1, 2012 and March 31, 2013. The tables exclude convictions arising from offences committed outside of the Northwest Territories.

During the 2012/2013 Fiscal Year, there were 138 convictions under the *Criminal Code*, a 15.9 percent decrease from the previous Fiscal Year. There were 2,267 convictions under the *Motor Vehicles Act*. This is a 1.2 percent increase from 2011/2012.

Section 8.0 shows the number of permits issued by type and issuing location, number of Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance (CVSA) inspections conducted and number of commercial transport-related convictions under the *Motor Vehicles Act* and *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act* for the 2012/2013 Fiscal Year. This section also includes the number of Deh Cho Bridge toll permits issued by toll class and associated revenue.

During 2012/2013

- 14,582 permits were issued;
- 1,020 CVSA inspections were conducted;
- There were 233 commercial transport-related convictions under the *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act* and *Regulations* as well as under commercial transport-related regulations pursuant to the *Motor Vehicles Act*; and
- \$947,080.00 in toll revenue was collected since the Deh Cho Bridge opened to traffic on November 30, 2012.

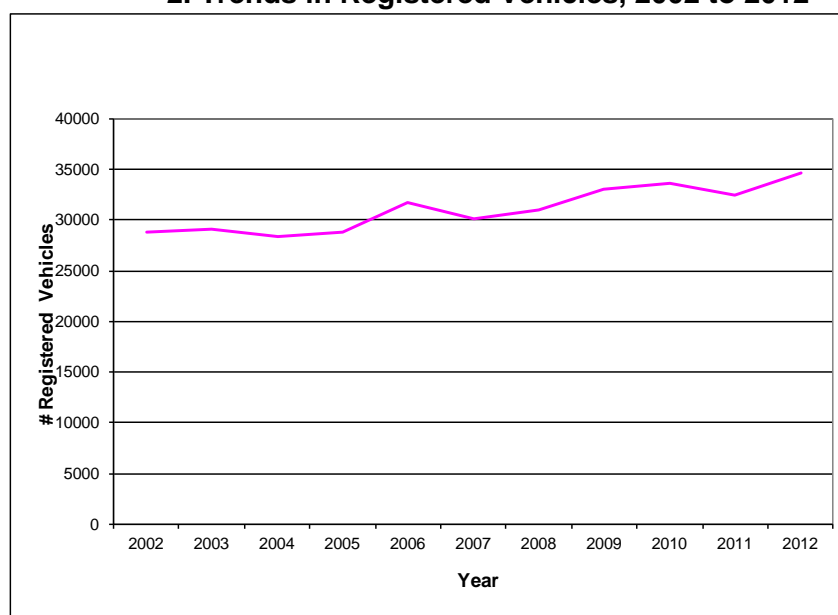
Section 9.0 presents a summary of reportable collisions in the Northwest Territories for the 2011 and 2012 calendar years. A reportable collision is an incident involving one or more motor vehicles resulting in death, personal injury or a minimum of \$1,000 in property damage for collisions occurring on or before December 31, 2011. The reporting threshold for property damage only collisions increased to \$2000 on January 1, 2012. Caution should be used in comparing the characteristics of property damage only collisions in 2012 to those in 2011 and earlier. Details on traffic collisions are presented in the publication entitled “2012 NWT Traffic Collision Facts” and include collisions occurring on the NWT Highway system. This publication contains useful information on issues that affect collisions and their severities, such as drinking and driving; unsafe speed; young and old drivers; and use of occupant restraints. 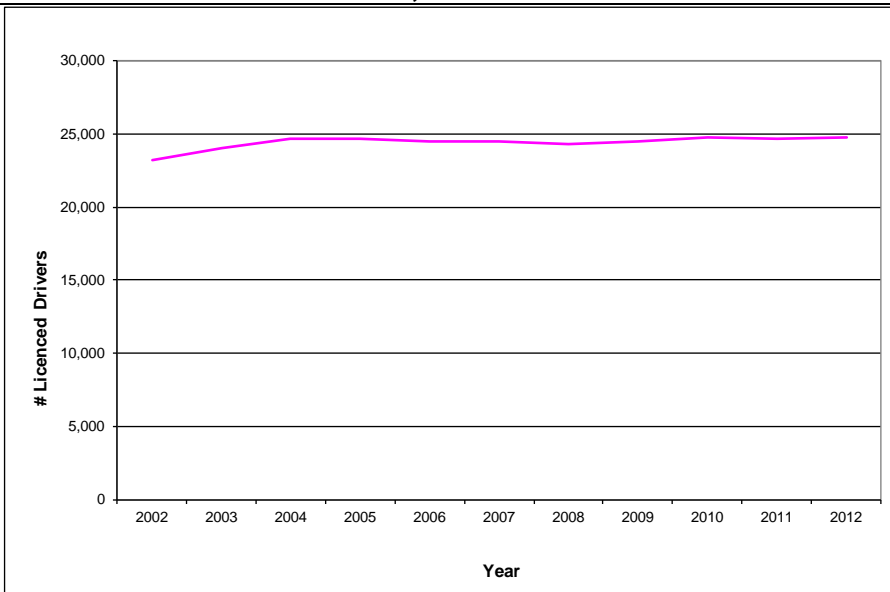

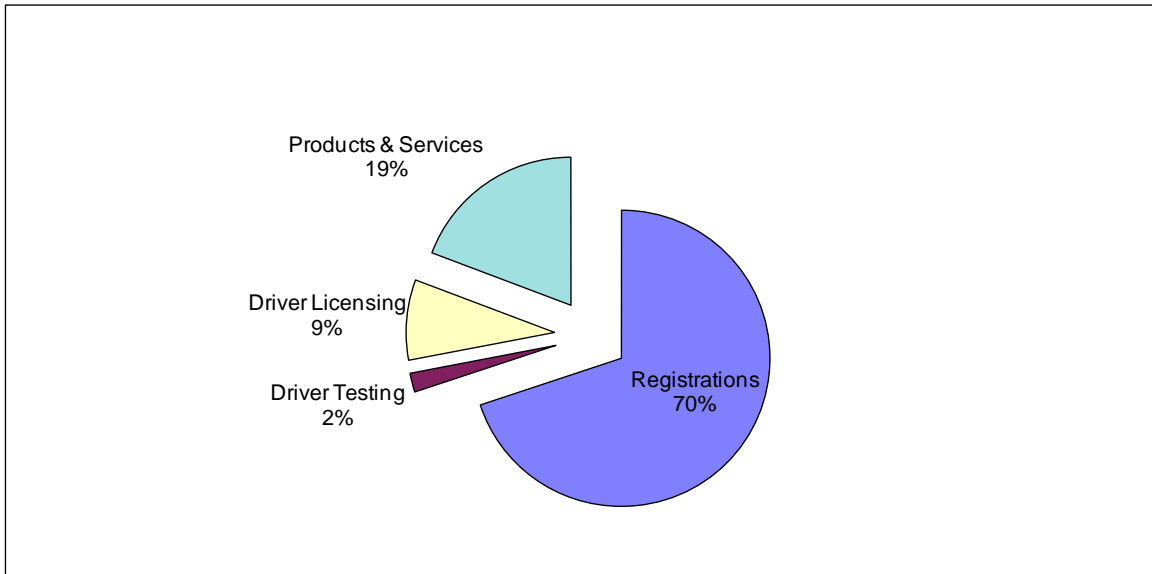

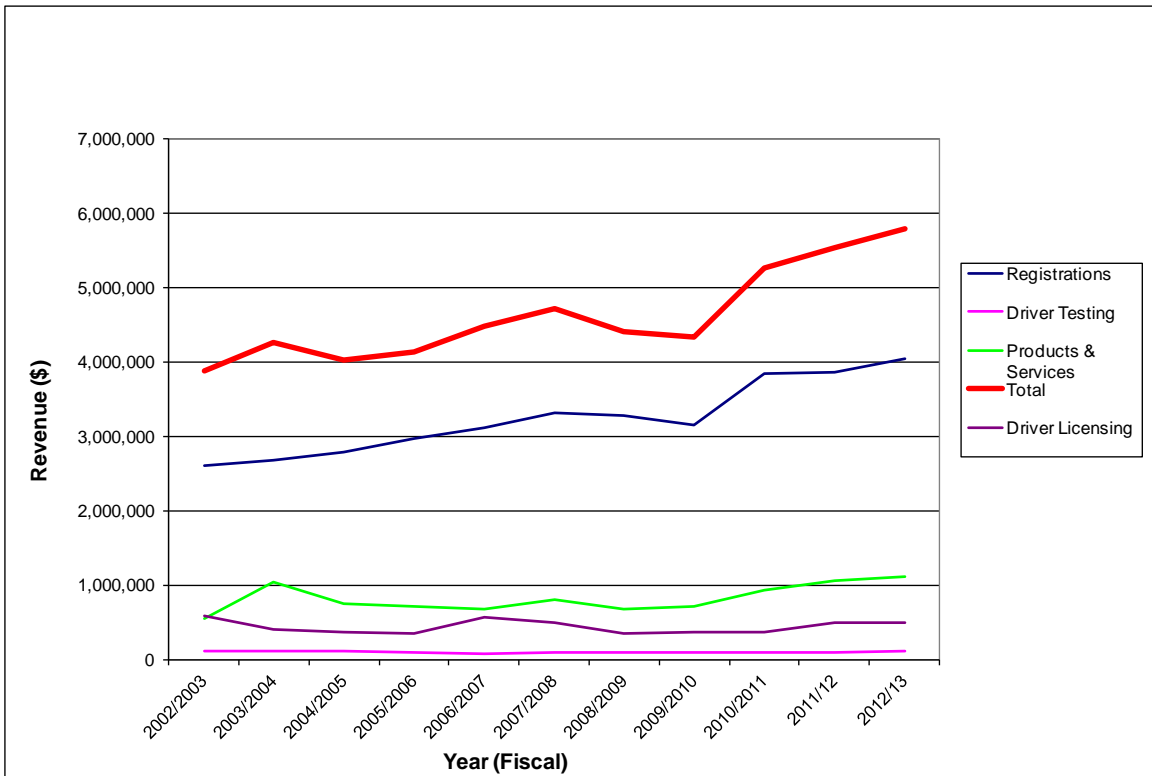

10. Trends in Revenue, 2002/2003 to 2012/2013



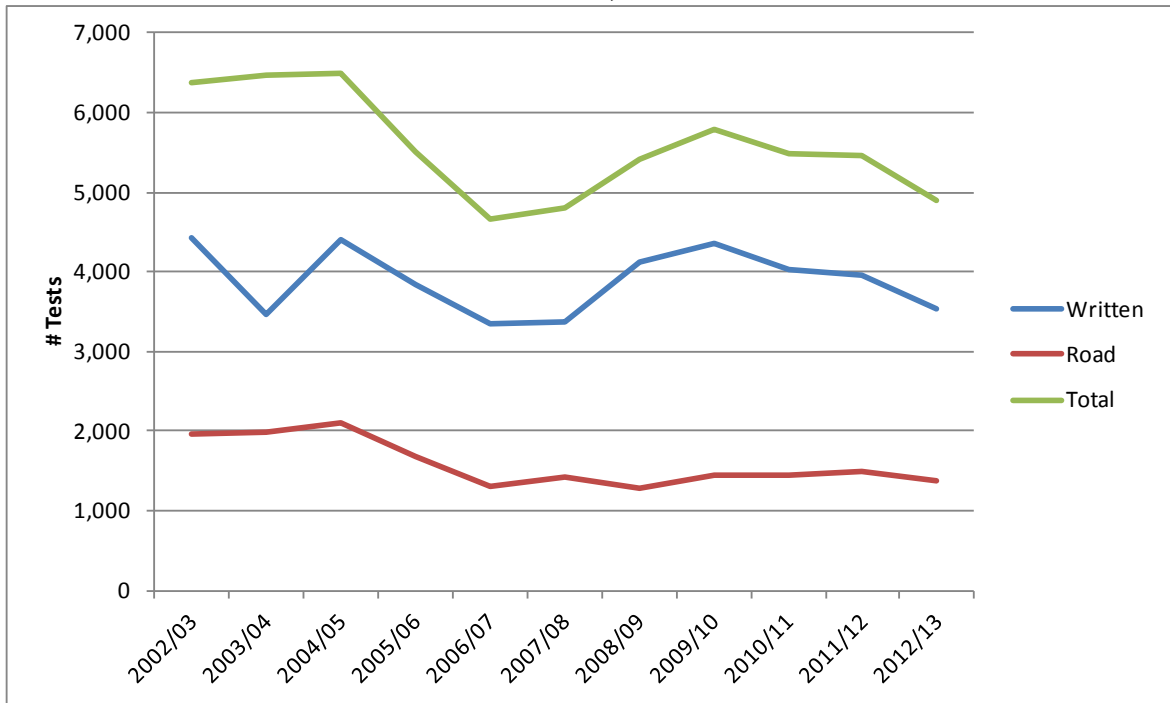
11. Total Driver Exam Count by Class, Test Type and Region (2012/2013 Fiscal Year)

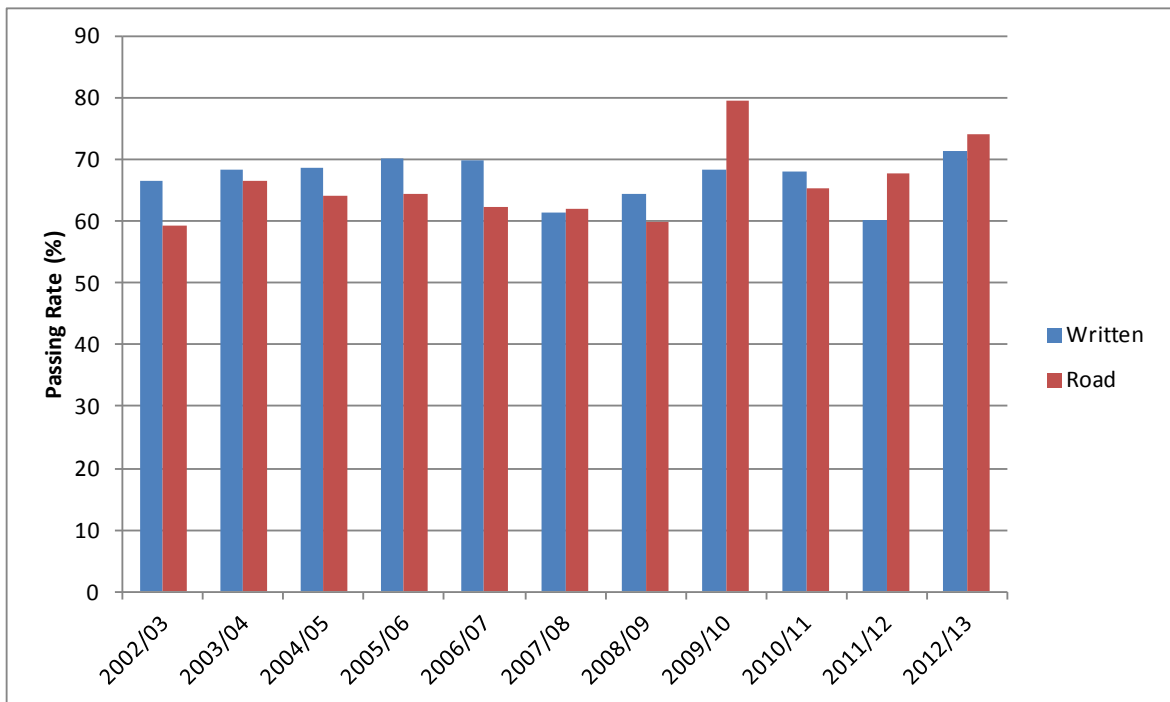

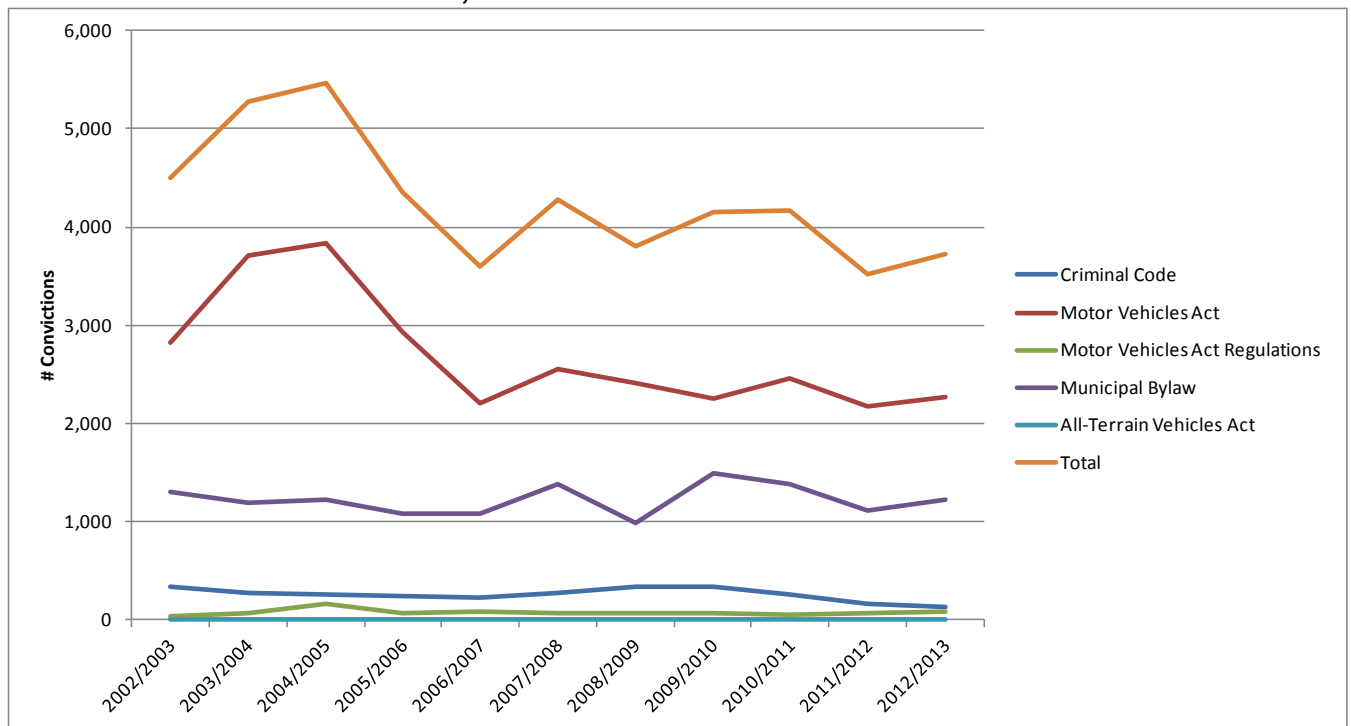

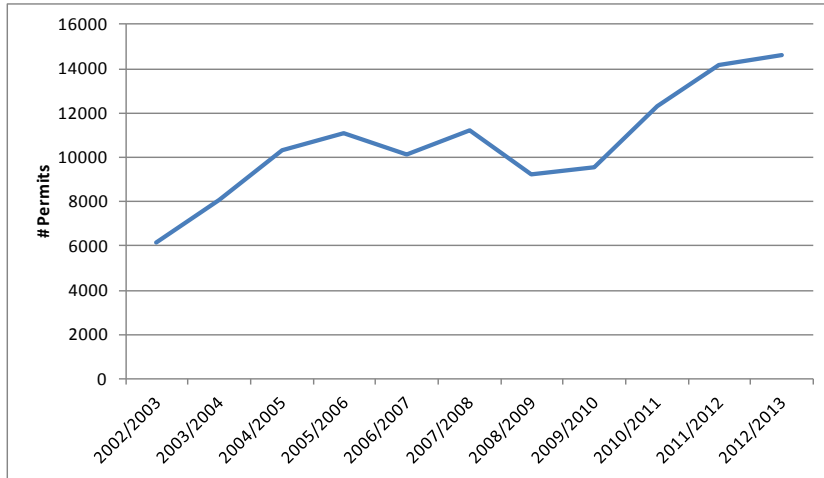

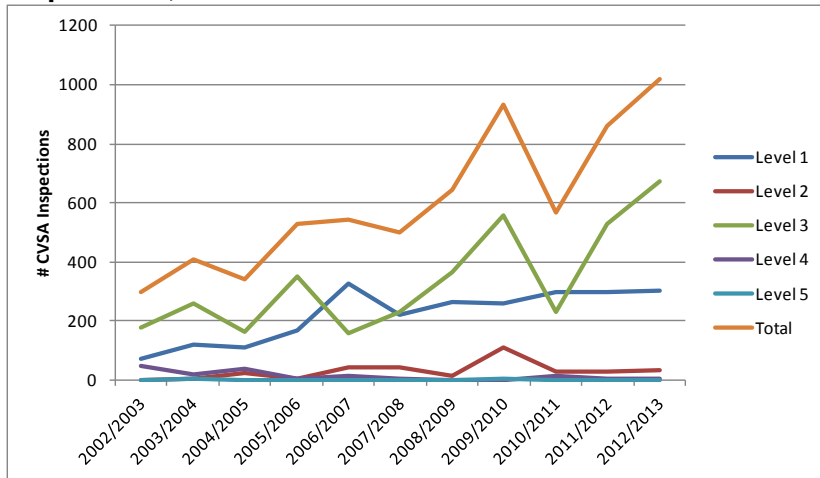

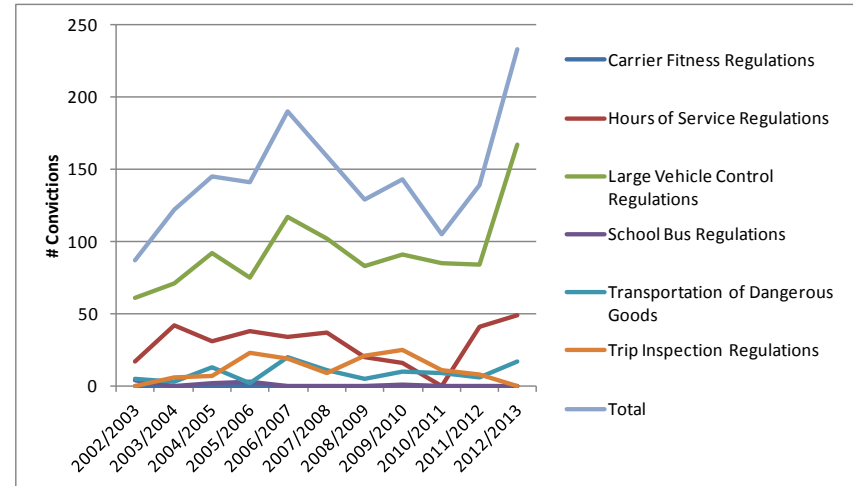
25. Trends in Commercial Transport Permits, 2002/2003 to 2012/2013
